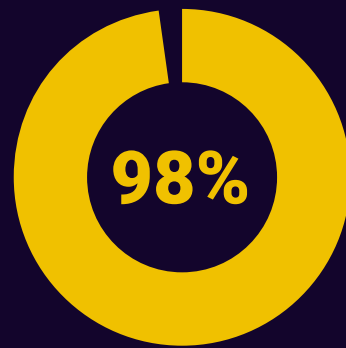

The 2016 EMS was an excellent blend of speakers and panel discussions dealing with relevant and important manufacturing issues. The broad spread of speakers showcased real-world examples of operational excellence, from across a wide spectrum of manufacturing operations. You'll see an even stronger focus on Industry 4.0, with multi sector implementation and enhancement case studies on the agenda.

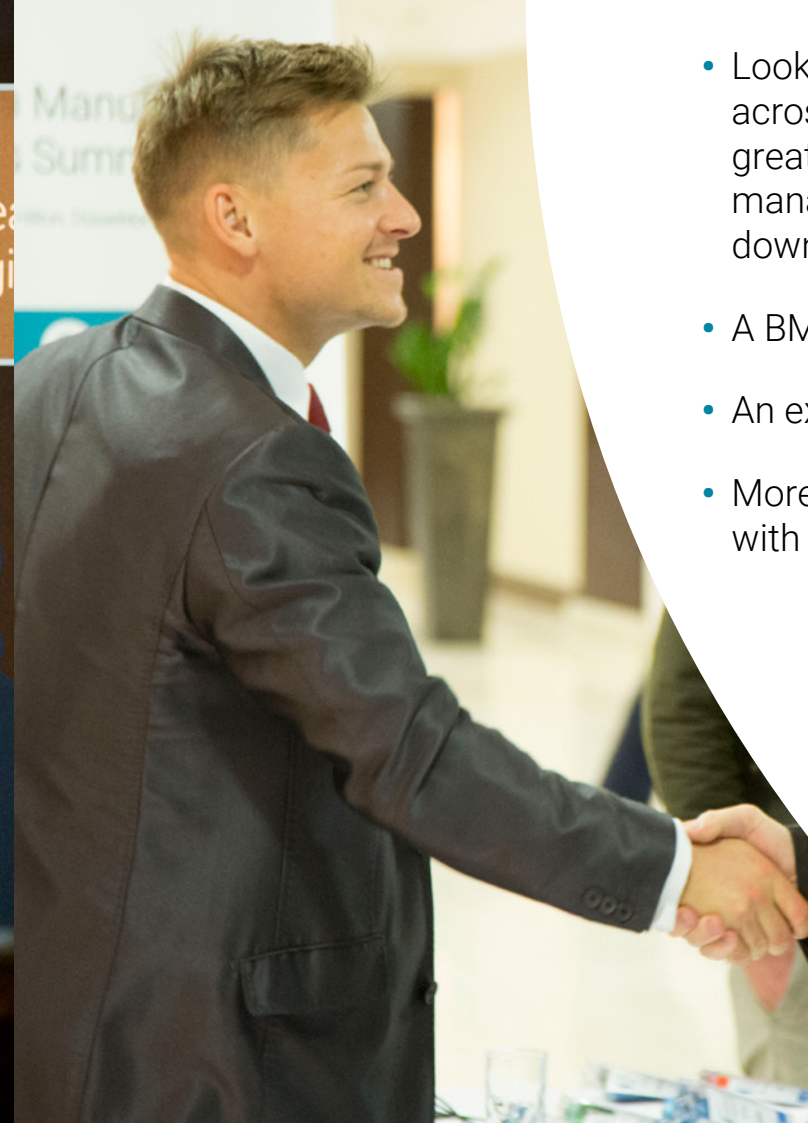
We'll be looking at operational excellence not only across the factory floor but beyond. With a greater and more detailed focus on quality management, supply chain integration and downstream manufacturing.

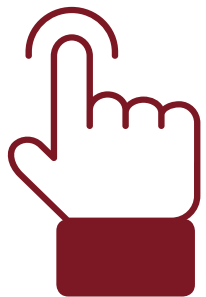
