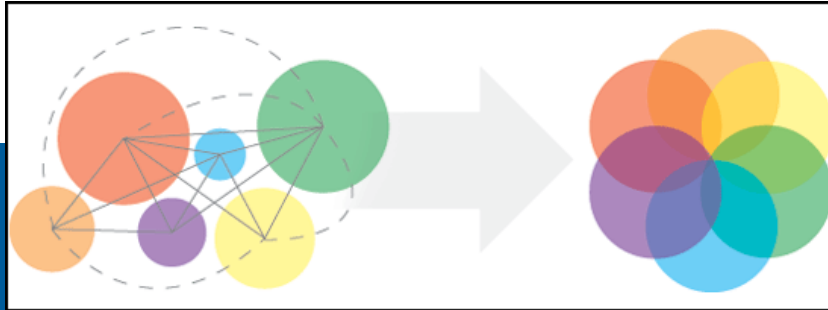

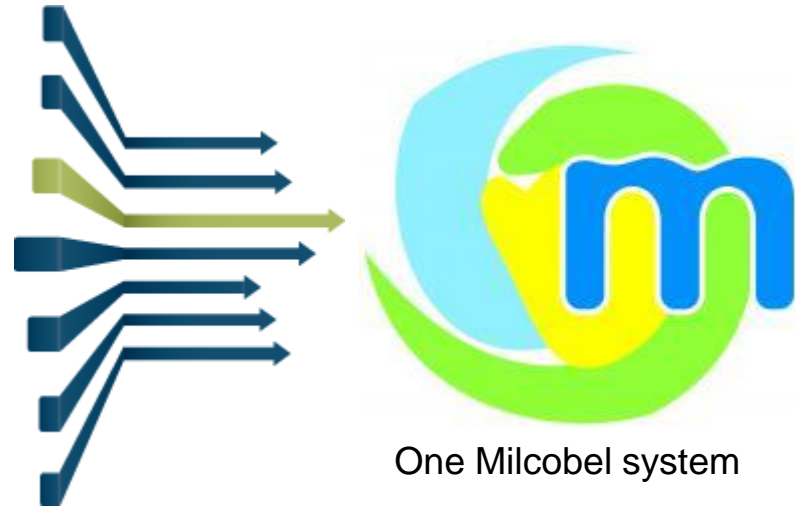

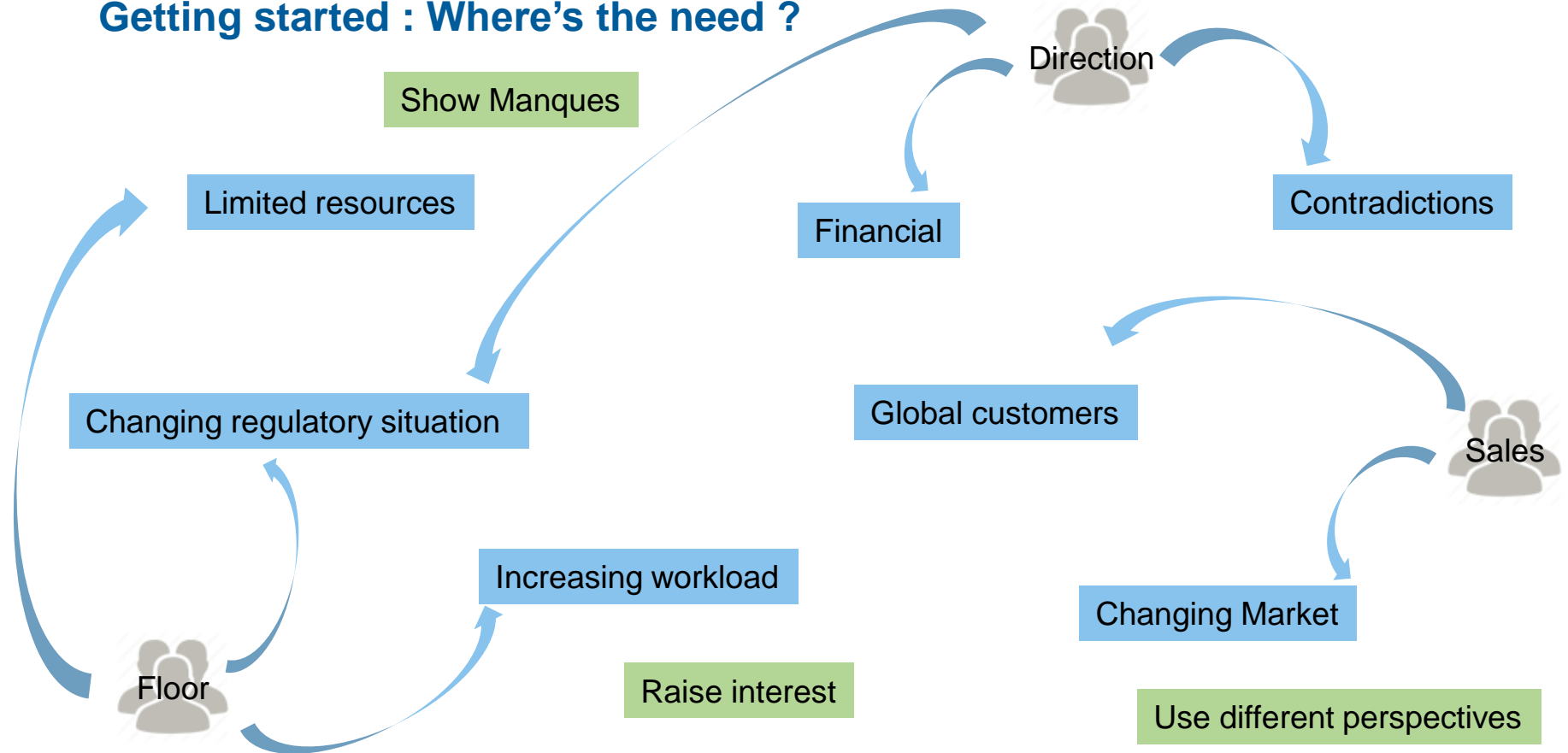

- Different control & sampling plans



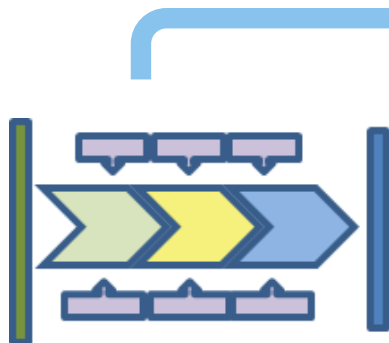

 - Allow time!!!

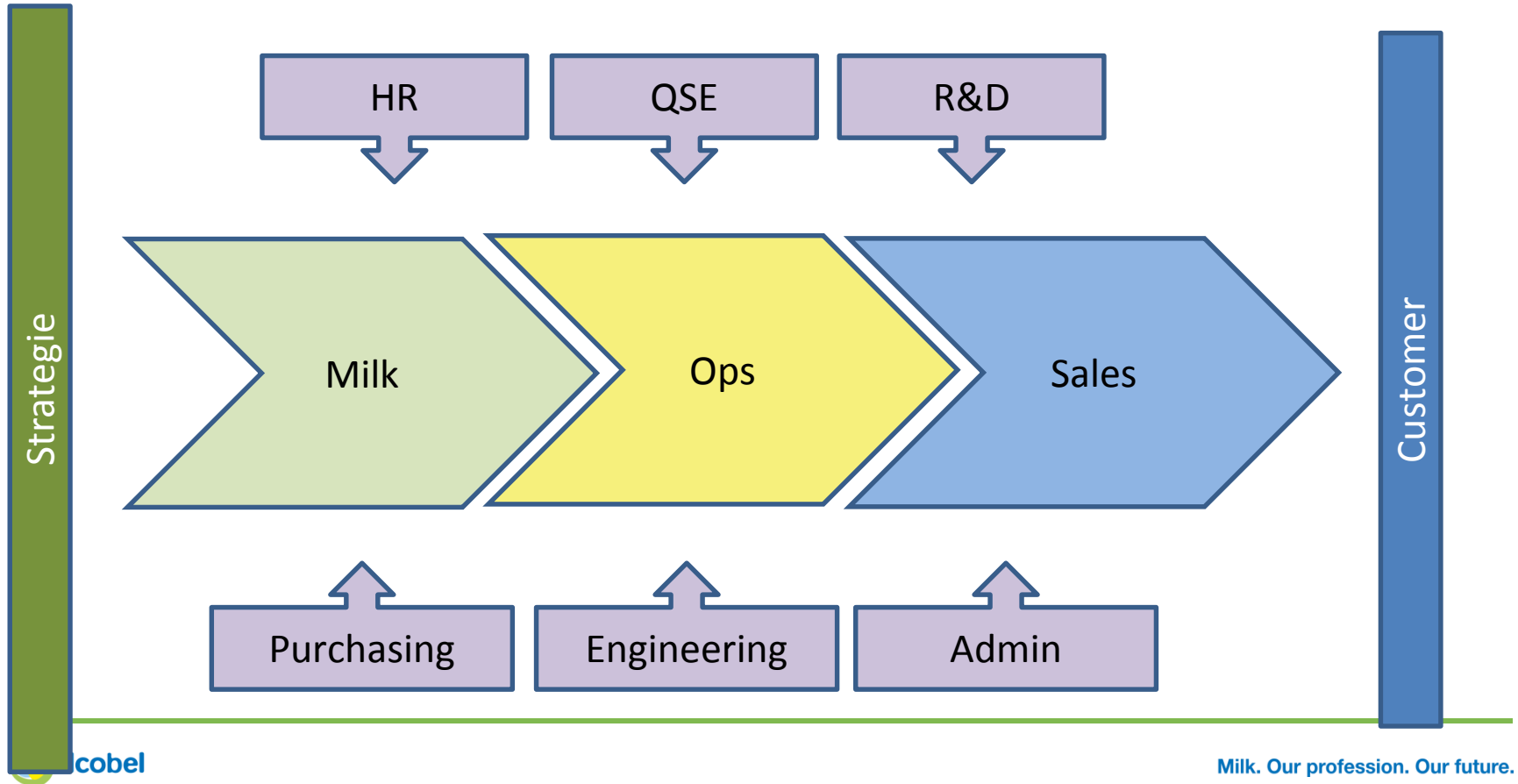

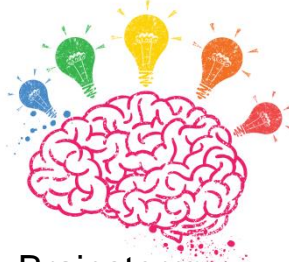

 - Involve
 - Strong Process Owners
 - Common decisions
- No time :
 - Direction support
 - Argumentation
- Everything at once :
 - Set up a plan – step by step
 - Show the first results
- Process stands still:
 - Answer the needs & problems
 - Audit (involve everyone!)
- Too many details to manage:
 - Helicopter view
 - Different layers of system
- 2-Speed system :
 - Highlight advantages
 - Develop support tools
 - Use ambassadors
- Back to old habits:
 - Get rid of old documents
 - Make the gap too big to come back

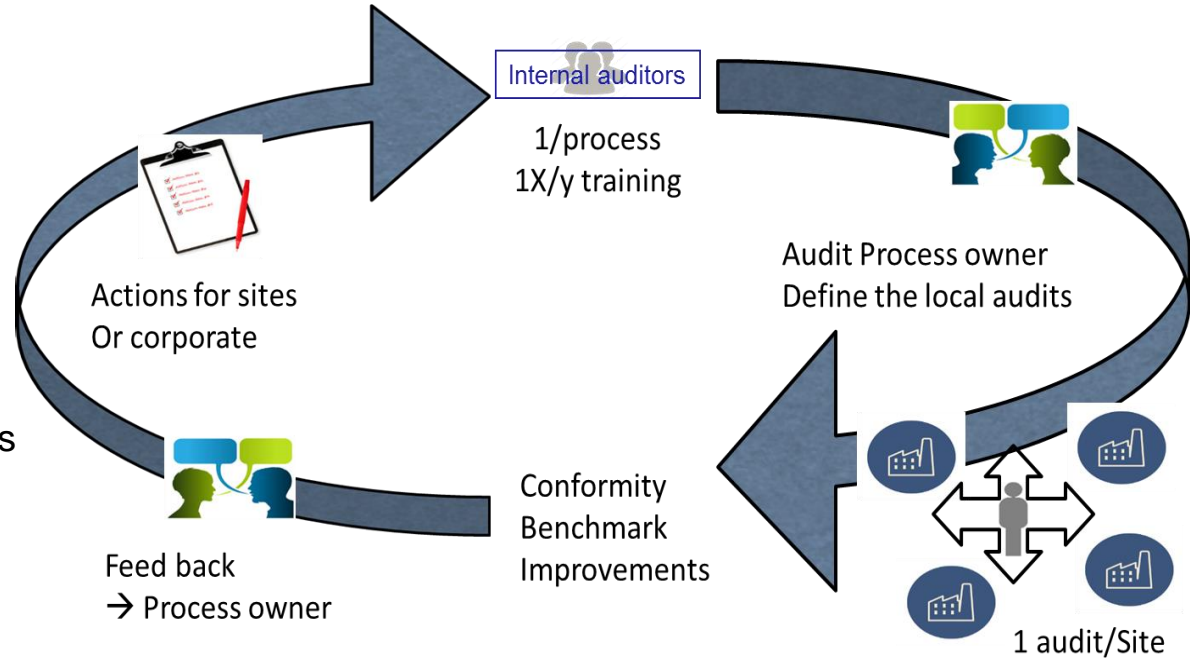
